**Fitness requirements – Season 2020-21** Every referee is encouraged to pass the fitness test.

Those wishing to be considered for appointment at Levels 5 and 6 must pass the appropriate fitness test. Due to the current uncertainties caused by CoVid -19, the dates by which testing will be required cannot be made available yet. Testing dates will be made known as soon as possible after information about the resumption of rugby is clear.

Anyone at level 6 or above who has not passed their fitness test will not be appointed to level 6 or above games unless no qualified level 6 or above referee is available. If they do not successfully complete their fitness test by the mid-season grading meeting, they will be automatically be moved to level 7. After this point the normal Grading Promotion/Relegation process will be followed.
